Here's an update since we attended the Harborough '75 event last weekend.

Nutfield & Raymond at Foxton

In spite of the rain on Saturday, overall, we had a successful weekend at Foxton, and *Nutfield* took part in the Saturday cavalcade to Market Harborough. However, as the crew were winding the boat to bring her back to join *Raymond*, a bolt sheared in the gearbox leaving us without reverse gear. We managed to get a tow, so the boats are together but they have had to remain at Foxton until the gearbox is repaired. Dave Ross from Brinklow Boats Services is coming out tomorrow (Monday) morning, so fingers crossed he'll get *Nutfield* up and running again.

The plan now is to move *Nutfield & Raymond* down to Crick on Wednesday, with a possible stop at Husbands Bosworth for children from the local primary school to visit the boats, and to move them on to Braunston on Thursday morning. This will get them back in time for *Raymond* to go into the wet dock on Friday morning for further repairs and painting before the rally.

And talking of the rally, don't forget it's on Saturday 28th and Sunday 29th June. *Nutfield & Raymond* will be taking part in the opening parade starting at 11.00 on Saturday morning. And there will be another parade at the same time on Sunday. In between times, we have been asked if we can offer trips on the boats in return for donations so, depending on the uptake, *Nutfield & Raymond* may be on the move several times over the weekend.

Over 90 historic boats are expected to attend this year's rally so there will be a lot to see, as well as a good chance of a trip on *Raymond* – although, regrettably, not on the Saturday opening parade as we are usually inundated with guests. Plus, of course, we'll have our extensive sales area by the arm, with lots of things to buy.

So, it promises to be a good day out and, if you come, do please stop by the stalls or the boats and say hello. We'd love to see you.

25th anniversary gathering at The Boat House
